Please understand the subsidy is completely at the discretion of your home Pastor. You will be responsible for the amount your church does not subsidize.</i></p> <p><i>**If child is not accepted, there will be a 50% refund of application fee.</i></p> <p><i>Families with more than one child will receive a 10% discount for the second student per family and a 20% discount for the third student per family. (Fourth Child and over are free)</i></p> <p><i>Students may be required to purchase school supplies and other materials required by their grade level. High School students are responsible for purchasing their own textbook.</i></p> <p><i>Financial Aid and Grants are available. This process begins in January.
