**To receive the Practicing Catholic rate, you must meet all requirements of your parish. Please complete the Pastor Recommendation Form and submit to YOUR pastor, as soon as you Enroll. These forms are due to the school no later than April 1st, 2018 to qualify for the Catholic Tuition Rate. Please understand the subsidy is completely at the discretion of your home Pastor. You will be responsible for the amount your church does not subsidize.*

***If child is not accepted, there will be a 50% refund of application fee.*

Families with more than one child will receive a 10% discount for the second student per family and a 20% discount for the third student per family. (Fourth Child and over are free)

Students may be required to purchase school supplies and other materials required by their grade level. High School students are responsible for purchasing their own textbooks.

Financial Aid and Grants are available. This process begins in January. Families needing assistance must apply.
